CABIN LEADS TO FRESH TEACHING START

A WLG timber cabin has enabled retired ex-deputy head teacher, Mrs Helen Whyment, to continue teaching at her farm, thanks to the cabin which was installed in the grounds of her farm in Pontardawe, Swansea, in 2004.

The cabin is now part of Mrs Whyment's new venture 'Brynglas Nursery' - an innovative project for the communities of Pontardawe and the Swansea Valley, providing a programme of horticultural education and training, which enables pupils and adult clients to benefit from her immense experience and knowledge.

From her cabin, Mrs Whyment is able to teach classes in a cosy, warm environment about the plants housed in the greenhouses nearby. "The cabin gives me enough room to enable me to teach ten pupils or clients comfortably, with additional space for computer terminals where they can investigate and learn about horticulture at their own pace. The cabin also has a verandah which means after a morning of learning, my clients can enjoy lunch in the outdoors and the views of the surrounding countryside."
